#### TODAY'S VISITORS - HINCKLEY RFC

Hoppers visitors today are Midlands side Hinckley who are currently lying in fourth place and not far from the play off position in National 2 North.

Hinckley have climbed the table in recent weeks thanks to a six match unbeaten run and have only lost on three occasions in thirteen outings since the two teams met back in early November, the same day as the World Cup Final incidentally.

Hoppers on the other hand have won just once in the same period, that against the only team lower than themselves in the table, Scunthorpe.

Hinckley returned to Level 4 rugby after securing promotion to National 2 North with a play-off victory over Cheshire side Wirral at the end of the 2015/16 season. Our hosts had led Midlands 1 for the major part of that season only losing top spot after the final league fixture at Scunthorpe who took the spoils together with the title on the day.

Before that promotion, Hinckley last graced this level of the rugby pyramid during 1999 and whilst Hoppers gained promotion at the end of that season our visitors fell back into the Midlands Leagues where they resided until their return a couple of seasons ago.

The Midlands Club played Level 4 rugby in what was then named National 3 North for just two seasons and added to their two previous defeats at Lightfoot Green with Hoppers gathering a rare victory during their 2017/18 relegation season.

All told there have been nine games between the two clubs, all league matches with the first being played at Lightfoot Green on the 20th of December 1997 when on that occasion Hoppers ran out winners by fifteen points to eight.

Hinckley haven't succeeded in tasting victory in their previous four visits to Lightfoot Green, whilst Hoppers have won just one of the five encounters at Leicester Road.

#### HEAD OF RUGBY OPERATIONS Gareth Dyer welcomed our visitors this week and said

"Good Afternoon and a warm welcome to Hinckley for today's National Two North fixture.

After the defeat against Tynedale two weeks ago and following meetings with the coaching staff and the rugby management, we have agreed to make some initial changes that will see us through to the end of the season.

Firstly, we said goodbye to Tom Davidson and Alex Hurst who have left us to join Wharfedale and Sedgley Park respectively. Tom had been player coach looking after the backs whilst Alex had been looking after our Strength &Conditioning requirements.

It was felt that it was in both the individuals and the clubs interests to go our separate ways and allow both guys to take up opportunities closer to where they live. They were two very hard working individuals and I want to place on record our thanks for their commitment to Hoppers during their time at Lightfoot Green.

To assist Paul and Donny for the rest of the season, I am delighted that Steve Kerry has taken up our offer to look after the back division coaching for the remaining games. Steve needs no introduction to the Hoppers faithful so I am not going to provide one!

We have decided to give a number of younger and fringe players opportunities during the remaining games. Hence, at times over the coming weeks you will see some new faces getting a taste of 1st XV rugby with one eye very much on the future.

I have asked our Head Physio Mark Taylor to provide me with an in depth injury audit for the season to date. The sustained volume of injuries we have experienced this season has wrecked our season and we need to understand what had been behind this.

At the end of last season, we felt we had been lucky with the number of injuries we sustained and took action to increase the squad's depth. Accepted practice is that you should plan to have at least 25% of your squad unavailable due to injury at any time.

In basic numbers that mean around 7 to 8 players not being available to us for selection each week. Our average this season has generally been 35-40% unavailable whilst at its worst we had over half of the squad unavailable when we travelled to Hinckley earlier in the season.

Some may say this is an excuse for poor performances and results. That is fine, I hear you but I'll get on with dealing with the reality rather than the conjecture."

#### HEAD COACH Paul 'Arnie' Arnold had this to say this week

"Good afternoon to everyone especially the Hinckley supporters, team and coaches.

Hinckley are having a great season and we know as every game in this league we have got to play at our best for 80 minutes if we want to get the win.

In patches in our last two games we have shown some good attacking intent but our decision making has let us down. This is something we have been working on in training.

These last 8 games will give us a chance to look at some new faces as part of the rebuilding process for next season and although this has already started we will be giving 100% until the end of the season. I'd like to also thank Tom Davidson and Alex Hurst for their contribution over the last two seasons and wish them well at their new clubs.

As always, thank you for your support in what's been a difficult season to say the least. But let's make some noise today and get behind these young lads and I'll see you in the bar afterwards."

This represents a tremendous concession and can only lead to an improved standard of Junior Rugby here at Preston Grasshoppers.

The Colts demonstrated tremendous team spirit throughout the season, which culminated in a successful end of season tour to Bristol. Several of the ex-Colts are currently enjoying pre-season training with the first and second team squad. Phill Mills will be lead coach for 2019/20, supported by First XV player Ryan Carlson and Ollie Hoban, a former Colt.


