TODAY'S VISITORS - SCUNTHORPE RUFC

Preston Grasshoppers entertain Scunthorpe today in what will be their first visit to Lightfoot Green since they spoiled the party in Hoppers first game on the AGP with a late try and conversion to win by a single point. Something that was a common occurrence that relegation season.

After being relegated along with Hoppers, our visitors took one more season than their hosts to regain their place in National 2 North. Scunthorpe topped Midlands Premier League at the end of last season, pipping Luctonians for the automatic promotion position by a single point.



Looking back to last Saturday, with just ten minutes remaining Hoppers gained what had looked like an improbable draw at Fylde thanks to a couple of tries and a coolly taken second conversion by new recruit Nick Gregson from out wide. The draw was Hoppers first for almost exactly two years to the day since the ten-all affair at Hull on the 16th of September 2017. If Hoppers could take their last twenty minutes of each half from this game forward better results will certainly be forthcoming!

Apart from bonus points, the draw gave Hoppers their first points at The Woodlands Memorial Ground since gaining victory there in 2001 and it was the first drawn game between the two since Mike 'Bill' Bailey's side shared the spoils in the 1996 Easter Monday match. This followed up a rare Hoppers victory at and over Fylde just a few weeks previous. These were the only games played between the two that season, with the Boxing Day fixture at Lightfoot Green being cancelled.

Back to this week's fixture. Preston Grasshoppers first met Scunthorpe during the 2002/2003 season then again during 2016/2017 when both were relegated to their respective Premier Leagues. Hoppers won both games in the first meetings before Scunthorpe took the spoils in the only other two games.

MILESTONES

Congratulations go to new boys Nick Gregson and John Blanchard who both made their debuts off the bench last Saturday with Nick's accurate conversion in the final few minutes giving us the draw. Ben Dorrington also featured in the game scoring one of the late tries which set up the comeback, his try coming less than ten minutes after he came on as a replacement!

After making his fiftieth appearance for Hoppers last week at Fylde, James Fitzpatrick will reach the same milestone in League games with his next appearance.

HOPPERS HEAD OF RUGBY OPERATIONS GARETH DYER PREVIEWS THE RUGBY WORLD CUP GROUP STAGES



After weeks of pre world cup friendlies and debates about selection, it is time for the talking to stop and for the action to begin.

Rugby World Cup 2019 starts this weekend and it is possibly the most

open tournament in the history of the cup.

New Zealand, South Africa, England, Ireland, Australia and Wales are all being talked up as being potential champions whilst France, Argentina and Fiji could all go deep into the tournament too. Watch out also for the hosts Japan. In a group with Ireland and Scotland, they will be hoping home advantage will give them a chance to make the knock out stages.

So with all features just like this, it's time to nail my colours to the mast and provide my predictions for the pool stages. (But given my historical record on predicting, don't rush to the bookies or bet the ranch on them!)

Pool A - Ireland, Scotland, Japan, Russia, Samoa

The Irish would appear to be group favourites but tomorrow's game with Scotland is crucial but perhaps even more so for the Scots. Scotland look a confidence team that if they get some momentum can then kick on. Lose and suddenly the game against Japan would seem to be a shootout for qualification. I don't think Ireland will struggle to put Japan away as their pack would seem more capable of subduing Japanese intentions to play at a furious pace to unsettle their more physical opponents. Samoa don't appear to be the force of old and a lack of

detailed preparation will count against them. Russia will unfortunately be the

whipping boys of the group.

Prediction: Group Winners: Ireland. Also Qualify: Scotland (after a few tense moments along the way against Japan and Samoa)

Pool B - New Zealand, South Africa, Italy, Namibia, Canada

In terms of the two to qualify this would seem the most straightforward of groups to predict with the two heavy-weights certain to go through. By the time you read this the key game between the All Blacks and the Boks will have taken place earlier today and the winners of that will top the group. The winners of that might just be the winners of the whole thing. It will be an epic battle and very close to call. Could a draw be a possibility? The rest of the group will be hoping not if both sides then need to rack up the points against the rest of the teams to top the group. Even if not, their tournaments look like they will be long and far from enjoyable.

Prediction: Group Winners: New Zealand (after a tight win over the Boks). Also Qualify: South Africa

Pool C - England, France, Argentina, USA, Tonga

This looks the toughest of groups with this morning's game between the French and Argentina being another key pool game in the wider context of the tournament. The winners of that will then go head to head with England to top the group. England will welcome games with Tonga and USA first up to fine tune before the games with Argentina and a last round game with France. Argentina seem to peak for World Cup's but France look like they are starting to meet the required levels of conditioning and discipline to make the most of the skill at their disposal. Hence I expect both England and France to arrive at the final pool game unbeaten for a winner takes all encounter.

Prediction: Group Winners: England (battle hardened but in good shape for the knock outs). Also Qualify: France (still a little short of winning the group but improving nicely)

Pool D - Australia, Wales, Fiji, Georgia, Uruguay

Can Fiji shock either Australia or Wales? Their backline looks frighteningly capable of upsetting someone and this morning's game between the Wallabies and Fiji will have answered one of those permutations. The Wales Australia game also appears another of the key pool games. Scotland are a momentum team and hence need some positive results early in the pool if they are to avoid complications later in the pool stages. Australia could also do with a shot in the arm after a period of indifference.

Prediction: Group Winners: Australia (their greater cutting edge might just be enough to beat the Welsh defence). Also Qualify: Wales (already injuries appear to be causing concern).

This in itself is a tremendous platform for future growth. Two Junior age groups with high numbers played double fixtures throughout the season, thereby ensuring all youngsters enjoyed game time.

The Artificial Grass Pitch, entering its fourth year, has proved to be an invaluable asset, not only allowing more rugby to be played by an increasing number of youngsters but also leading to improved management of the grass pitches. The RFU now appreciates the challenge of providing mid-week training for over two hundred youngsters and has arranged for the club to pre-book two hours on the AGP every Wednesday evening. This represents a tremendous concession and can only lead to an improved standard of Junior Rugby here at Preston Grasshoppers.

The Colts demonstrated tremendous team spirit throughout the season, which culminated in a successful end of season tour to Bristol. Several of the ex-Colts are currently enjoying pre-season training with the first and second team squad. Phill Mills will be lead coach for 2019/20, supported by First XV player Ryan Carlson and Ollie Hoban, a former Colt.

- Finally, improve the availability of professional coaches to the Junior age groups.




