#### TODAY'S VISITORS - WHARFEDALE

Preston Grasshoppers meet opposition from Yorkshire for the third consecutive time this Saturday in the shape of Wharfdale.

Wharfedale have had a mixed bag of results so far this season, winning 7 games but losing 10. However, following a big win against Scunthorpe last weekend, their tails will be up this afternoon and we will have to be on our guard. Wharfedale had this match sewn up by halftime with five converted tries on the score board to lead by 35 – 0. Scunthorpe had the wind and the slope in the second half and their resilience was rewarded with two tries. This was after the home side had stretched the lead to 49 points in the first 10 minutes with two more tries.



Hoppers and Wharfedale have met in League action on just eleven occasions in the past with the Yorkshire side leading the way with seven wins against Hoppers four. Before the two clubs met each other in League action, there were four Club Games, the first of these taking place at Lightfoot Green back on the 1st of April 1991 when our opponents went under the name of Upper Wharfedale in the fixture book and whilst Hoppers were competing in National 3 North, our opponents league fixtures took place two levels below in North 2. A sign of things to come from the Yorkshire club came with the visitors achieving a narrow victory on the day by ten points to four. In the return fixture the following season in Yorkshire, Hoppers recorded their first victory at that venue by eighteen points to twelve.

Apart from the pre-season practice game over in The Dales prior to the 2009/10 season in which the home side came out winners by thirty eight points to twenty one, there have been sixteen matches played between the two clubs at 1st XV level with Wharfedale leading the way by eleven wins to Hoppers five.

#### HEAD OF RUGBY OPERATIONS Gareth Dyer welcomed our visitors this week and said

"Good Afternoon and welcome to the players, coaches and supporters from Wharfedale RUFC for today's National Two North fixture. A look at the league table tells everything you need to know about the importance of this fixture.

With Huddersfield travelling to Scunthorpe today you would expect them to take all five league points. Luctonians meanwhile are at home to runaway leaders Caldy and if that goes to form then you would find it hard to make a case for Luctonians to take the win.

Hull and Otley aren't clear of danger either with tricky home games against Chester and Hinckley respectively.

In fact, a look at the next three weeks suggests that those teams just outside the relegation zone have some very difficult looking fixtures ahead of them. Both Hull and Otley have to face Caldy whilst both Wharfedale and Luctonians have Sheffield Tigers to face.

We travel to Huddersfield next week who then host Wharfedale the week after.

Hence, the permutations look very interesting with a lot of matches in the next three weeks being very much in the 8 (or even 10) pointer category. We can do ourselves an enormous amount of good with a win today before we travel to Huddersfield.

We were very disappointed not to prevail last week at Sheffield Tigers. The game was played in very difficult conditions with the wind gusting to 50mph at times during the game. There was very little in the game and nothing to choose between the two sides. We had a difficult penalty kick chance which was well struck by Tom Davidson but agonisingly the wind pushed the kick at the last minute to the side of the upright.

Those fine margins have been the tale of the season.

At Threshfield in the earlier fixture against Wharfedale, we had a kick to take the lead in the final minutes after a strong comeback. There was little to choose between the sides that day and we both come into the game with reasonable form behind us. We have played well in the last two weeks and we recognise what needs to be done.

Clearly the pressure is now on those sides battling at the bottom but nothing is decided in January and our destiny still remains in our hands. I'm sure there will be a vocal travelling support so hopefully the home support will be just as vocal. It is time for us all to stand up to be counted."

#### HEAD COACH Paul 'Arnie' Arnold had this to say this week

"Firstly, a Happy New Year to all at the Hoppers, it's good to be back at home for the first time this year and I would like to extend a warm welcome this week to our friends from Wharfedale including coaches, players and supporters in what is a crucial game for us today. Last week everyone without exception put their hearts and souls into a gritty 11-10 loss away at Sheffield Tigers. I was pleased to see the effort and desire to win was there from all the players which was evident to those loyal spectators who travelled in support. The game was played in atrocious conditions and we had a slim chance of a win with a late long distance penalty only to be thwarted by a last minute gust of wind. The players were all gutted not to come away from Threshfield without the win.

A few notable names were missing last week and we are missing John Blanchard this week having been recalled by Sale FC. Big thanks to Blanny for all his efforts in a Hoppers shirt and hopefully he will be returning soon.

We have two crucial games coming up and we will be doing everything we can to get the results we need to help us climb up the table. Matt Lamprey has had an operation to remove an abscess from his leg and after a few days in hospital is now recovering at home. Captain Paul "PJ" Millea is also recovering after his heart scare."

#### **GEORGE ERDOZAIN STEPS DOWN**

After more than 12 years of sterling service the Club's Chairman, George Erdozain, has decided to step down from the rôle.

George took over at short notice, giving up his then role as President, at a time when the club was at a low ebb. In the 12 years he has overseen a turnaround in the Club's fortunes and in particular:

- The appointment of a full time professional General Manager
- An increase in the Club's commercial turnover of 400%
- A widening of the Club's sponsorship and support base producing more than 4 times the previous revenue
- A reduction in debt from over £500k to less than £50k
- An expansion of the playing side of the club to encompass Ladies Rugby
- The RFU's decision to locate an AGP at the Club as they recognised we were the best run club in the area
- The sale of the car park in order to permit new development

George has been unstinting in his commitment to the Club not only in day to day matters but representing it in National forums. He was a leading light in opposing the changes Twickenham tried to force onto the clubs at the last Adult Rugby Review and his trenchant views have been noted by the RFU. The Management Committee has regretfully accepted George's resignation. Up until the AGM they have determined to share George's many tasks between themselves. The appointment of a new Chairman is a matter for the members and the time up to the AGM will give the members time to consider who they might like to take up that position. Any member wishing to know more about the rôle is welcome to discuss it with any member of the Management Committee. The Management Committee are keen to widen participation in running the Club and any member keen to help. by standing for the Committee or otherwise, is urged to make themselves known.

In due course ways to mark George's stepping down will be publicised but George was keen that members should know sooner rather than later of his decision.

He is guite clear we have not seen the last of him down at the Club so members will have ample opportunity to chat to a George relaxed and carefree without the burdens of office! The odd pint will be no doubt appreciated. The Club now needs to build on the legacy that George has left. We are facing exciting times with a number of changes on the professional management side of the Club and development of the clubhouse. Your Management Committee are determined to take the Club onwards and upwards.

#### MINI JUNIOR AND COLTS RUGBY AT LIGHTFOOT GREEN

In terms of registered players, 2018/19 saw 400 plus youngsters enjoy the rugby experience at Hoppers. Not only did the number of volunteer coaches and managers increase by 20%, but also there was a planned and effective focus on achieving the England Rugby Coaching Award. This in itself is a tremendous platform for future growth. Two Junior age groups with high numbers played double fixtures throughout the season, thereby ensuring all youngsters enjoyed game time.

The Artificial Grass Pitch, entering its fourth year, has proved to be an invaluable asset, not only allowing more rugby to be played by an increasing number of youngsters but also leading to improved management of the grass pitches. The RFU now appreciates the challenge of providing mid-week training for over two hundred youngsters and has arranged for the club to pre-book two hours on the AGP every Wednesday evening. This represents a tremendous concession and can only lead to an improved standard of Junior Rugby here at Preston Grasshoppers.


